Tony Valeri joined ArcelorMittal Dofasco in June 2011 from his own firm, Ridge Strategy Group, a public affairs and management consulting company. Tony was also a Member of Parliament for four consecutive terms, beginning in 1993.

During his terms in office, he served as Minister of Transport and subsequently led the government's legislative program as Leader of the Government in the House of Commons. Prior to assuming public office, he was principal of a life and health benefits practice.

In his role as vice president, Valeri oversees the corporate communication unit, which acts as the voice of ArcelorMittal Dofasco to all stakeholders, including employees, protecting and building the company's reputation, and enhancing the ArcelorMittal brand in Canada. He is also responsible for government relations, which is focused on enhancing corporate performance and strategic business opportunities of ArcelorMittal Dofasco by mitigating political risk and identifying partnership opportunities with governments at all levels.

Valeri is a graduate of McMaster University and is actively involved in the community. He is currently a board member and chair of the Quality Committee of St. Joseph's Health System, and a board member of the Hamilton/Burlington United Way. Valeri was also a member of the Board of Trustees of St. Joseph's Healthcare Hamilton, holding the position of board chair from 2009 to 2011. He was a former director of the Global Governing Board of the Caux Round Table, a network of senior business leaders who share common values and conviction that business should assume a leadership role in bringing positive changes in society.
